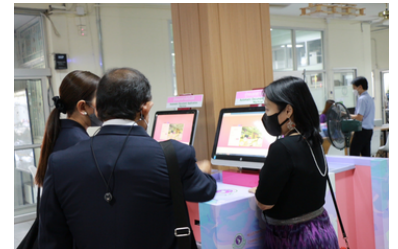

After the announcement of course enrollment (December 4, 2022), can students enroll/add/change section?

- Students still can enroll in courses via the Online Registration System by selecting menu "Late Enrollment" > "Late Course Enrollment" or "Late University Services Enrollment." BUT tuition fee **with fine** must be paid for the enrollment to be considered complete.

• Course addition is still available via the Registration System. The result of successful course addition will show in CMR51, but late-added courses will not appear in the semester's CMR50 (Course Enrollment Form). Students can check from the list of enrolled course(s) instead. Section change for enrolled course is also available in the Registration System.

• **Reminder!** REG advise you to pay tuition fee before adding courses or changing section. If the payment is not made, all the courses enrolled will disappear.

Enrollment for University Services for Graduate Students

Get to Know the Letter Grade V



What is a V grade?

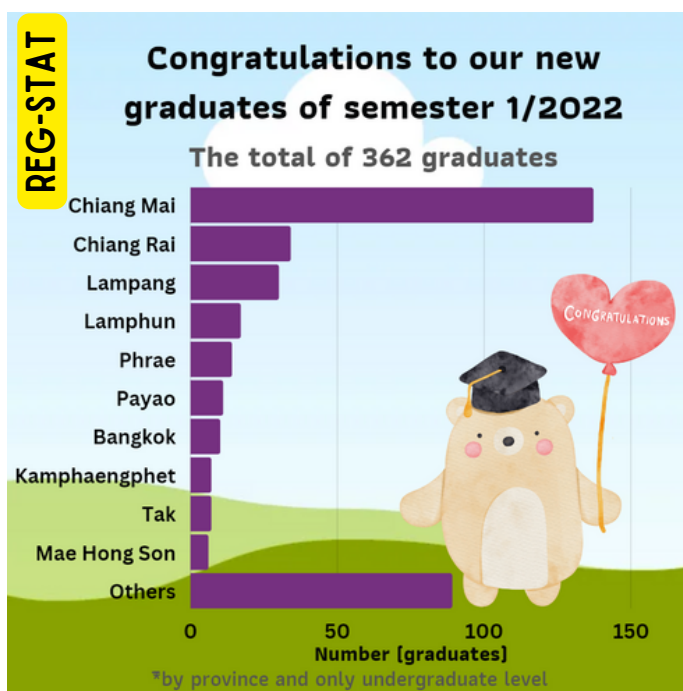
Letter grade V (Visiting) is a letter grade without point value granted to students who wish to enroll in courses as visitors. Visiting students can attend the class for knowledge enrichment and will not receive an evaluation for the course. However, visiting students must attend no less than 80 percent of class hours and meet the course's requirements. If not, the instructor may consider replacing the V grade with a W grade.

How to apply for a V grade?

Once the enrollment is announced, submit a request for a V grade in the Registration System. For undergraduate students, requesting and changing the grade V to regular enrollment must be carried out within a specified time period (December 12 – 16, 2022). For graduate students, requesting a V grade (December 12 – 16, 2022) and changing the V grade to regular enrollment are of different schedules. Please note that once students receive a V grade for a course, they cannot re-enroll in the same course unless the course is required for transferred students.

Who must approve my grade V request?

To request for V grade, students must obtain approval from their advisor, instructor, and the head of the department/school to which the course belongs. Evidence of approval must be uploaded to the Registration System.
